# **Language Requirements**

Below is a brief summary of the language requirements that are necessary for studying at Leeds as a Study Abroad/Exchange student.

### **Erasmus Students**

Your level of English Language will be assessed by your home University and you are not required to send further information to the University of Leeds. Although we don't require formal English language requirements you must have sufficient ability to follow classes, as they are all taught in English.

#### **Worldwide Exchange/Self-Funding Students**

If English is not your first language, you must hold an English Language qualification to gain entry to the University of Leeds\*. The two most commonly used are IELTS and TOEFL.

Students with high grades at IELTS or TOEFL will be eligible to apply for direct entry to the Study Abroad programme, commencing in either September or January.

Students with slightly lower grades need to apply to a pre-sessional English Language course before starting the Study Abroad Programme. You will apply by selecting this option when you complete the online application form.

Our minimum grade requirements depend on the subject you wish to study at Leeds, please see details below.

\*Students who currently study in English at their home institution do not need to provide English Language qualifications when applying to the University of Leeds. Please contact the Study Abroad Office if you are unsure of your situation.

#### **The University English Test**

If your first language is not English then you will be required to take the <u>University English Test</u> upon arrival. This test is used to identify those students who may find additional English language support useful. Please follow the link for more details.

## **English Language Courses**

The Language Centre at the University of Leeds offers English Language courses that start in April, July and August in any given year. All language tuition takes place at the Language Centre, which has modern language laboratories, excellent fully equipped classrooms, group TV/video areas and a laboratory for computer-based learning.
